Harborfields Community Educational Foundation Application Form Policies

The Harborfields Alumni and Community Education Foundation (HACEF) policies are as follows:

- The Scholarship Selection Committee of HACEF is a standing committee and has as its primary aim the annual awarding of one or more scholarship(s) to graduate(s) of Harborfields High School. Each senior of Harborfields High School can apply for only one (1) HACEF scholarship. The number and amount of scholarships offered will be determined by the Board of Directors of HACEF.
- The Scholarship Selection Committee of HACEF shall be solely responsible for the selection of all recipients and reserves the right to award a scholarship to recipients that they deem worthy of this honor.
- The intent of this award is to honor the recipient for his/her humanitarian efforts and to help defray the expense of the recipient's tuition, books, and maintenance in any course of study that will lead to the granting of one of the following:
 1. Baccalaureate degree in an accredited post-secondary school
 2. Associates degree in an accredited post-secondary school
 3. Certificate from an accredited vocational/technical/occupational school
- The scholarship will be a check drawn and presented at the senior awards night or mailed to the successful recipient by the HACEF treasurer.
